What are PFAS ?



PFAS are persistent synthetic chemicals used in many products mainly for their surfactant properties, for example, as water and dirt repellents, hence their use in the leather industry. There are over **4 000 PFAS**, some of them have been deemed hazardous to health and the environment and recently regulated.
